11 + Registration - Year 5 Pupils

Please note that online registration for pupils to sit the 11+ examination in September 2021 will open on 1st May. Please register at https://www.wirral.gov.uk/schools-and-learning/school-admissions. We have sent home leaflets to parents with more information. Please note that the registration window closes on 31st May. If parents are unable to register online, they can obtain paper forms by calling the Call Centre on 0151 666 4600.

Parents who do not wish their child to sit the 11+ examination do not need to register. Upton Hall School, St Anselm's College and Birkenhead High School Academy have their own testing arrangements and parents should contact the schools directly for more details. 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New Telephone Switchboard

From **Monday 3rd May**, Dawpool will transfer to a new telephone system. When you dial the school's telephone number **0151 648 3412**, you will be presented with 4 options:

Option 1

Absence Line

To report your child's absence, please tell us your child's name, class and nature of illness. If your child is suffering from sickness, we ask that you follow NHS guidance and keep your child at home for 48 hours. Please remember to provide a written note when your child returns to school.

Option 2:

School Kitchen

Option 3:

COVID Symptoms

A reminder that your child <u>must not</u> attend school if they have any of the following symptoms:

- High temperature
- Cough
- Loss of taste or smell

If your child has any of these symptoms (even if you suspect it isn't COVID-19) they should have a PCR test at a symptomatic test centre and only return to school if the result is negative. Please note that lateral flow tests should not be used for primary aged pupils.

If your child has any siblings in school, they too should not attend but are not required to be tested if they are not showing symptoms.

Pupil Arrival Times

Please note that all pupils in Years 4, 5 & 6 (including younger siblings) must arrive in school by 8:40am.

Pupils in **Years 1, 2 & 3** (including siblings in F1 & F2) must arrive in school in by **8:50am**.

Pupils in **F1 and F2** (without siblings in other year groups) must arrive in school by **9:00am**.

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Lessons start immediately, so if your child arrives in school after their scheduled time, they will miss important aspects of their learning.
