



If you do not get up to the school and wish to buy some tickets please send in a note with how many tickets you require



We also ask parents not to photograph their child during the performances. We will provide an opportunity for parents to take photographs at the end of each performance.






Year 4 Music Concert


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Christmas Jumper Day for 'Save the Children'

Uniform


We strive for the highest standards in every aspect of the school, including our children's uniform. Between the months of October and April, all pupils should be wearing the school's winter uniform as follows:

December: 'Local Parks'


Local parks are central to our neighbourhood and a fixture in most of our childhoods. A place for children to play, spend time with friends and get some fresh air.





There is a sliding scale at the top of the website, which filters age related material. It is a website used by Avon and Somerset Police and Merseyside Police to inform parents.




Attendance


For showing self-control and a mature attitude to work. We are so proud of you.
