




The Bazaar runs from 10-11.30am and then again 2-4pm in the school hall.


Adult Christmas Raffle





For safety reasons we ask all children with hair longer than collar length to have it fixed in a bun or plait.


As we order oranges in advance, it would be appreciated if you could ask your child to inform their class teacher as soon as possible if they are unable to attend this service.

The boxes to support Operation Christmas Child were collected on Monday. We sent off 75 boxes and thank you all for your support.





And the Diocesan Website has “52 Thoughts” - one for each week of the year.




