



Please note that the Local Authority can take into account special circumstances that may affect your child's attainment and performance in the grammar school assessment, for example if his or her education has been seriously disrupted through ill-health, domestic problems or any other cause.

If you believe that there are special factors that could have affected your own child's performance in the assessment, you should put them in writing to Mr Burrows by **Tuesday 19th September 2017** to be sent on to the Authority.

Parents will be notified of the results of the 11+ test by **21st October 2017**.

Secondary School Applications



Year 6 parents should have received a leaflet this week reminding you of key dates regarding secondary school applications. If you didn't receive a copy, you can download it from our website under the 'Our Parents' tab. Applications for secondary schools are to be completed online at www.wirral.gov.uk/schooladmissions and must be completed by **October 31st 2017** at the very latest.

After you have submitted your application, you will receive an email from the Local Authority within 24 hours to confirm receipt. If you do not receive a confirmation email, we advise that you call them on **0151 606 2020** to check they have received the application.




