



Chess Success


Some of our KS2 pupils participated in the Merseyside Chess Championships on Monday at St George's Hall.

The Under 8's came first and were Merseyside Champions and the Under 9's second, just missing out on first by half a point!


Mr Battersby reported that all children played very well and represented our school beautifully.

11+ Familiarisation


