

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
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Parents Evening

Silver Smarties


It is now time to return your Smarties tubes with any monies your children have earned by helping at home or making that special effort. Please send tubes in on this **Monday 7th November**.



Car Parking



Forest Schools






The Fruit of the Spirit Award is presented to pupils who have shown our Christian values in action.


