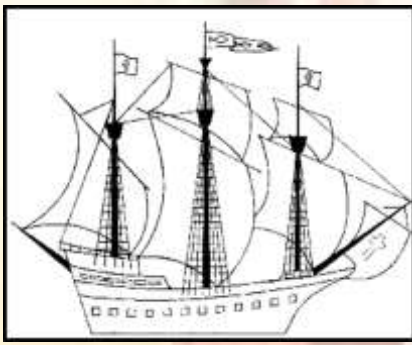
Father's Day Sale

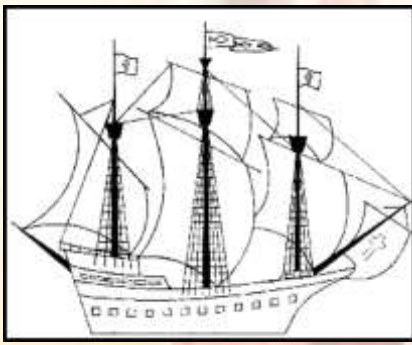
School Money

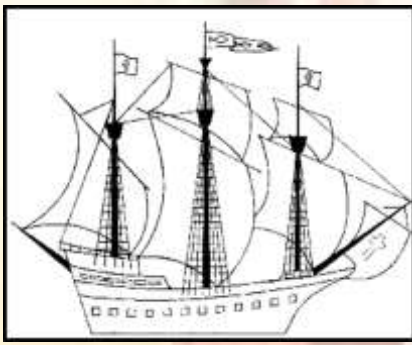
Bible Exhibition.
