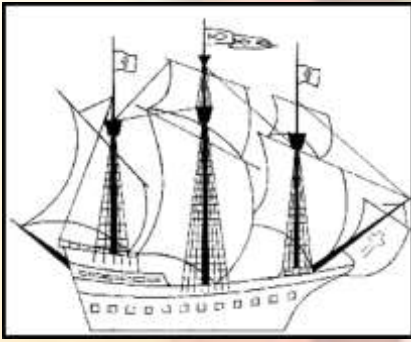

### Guess the bear's name

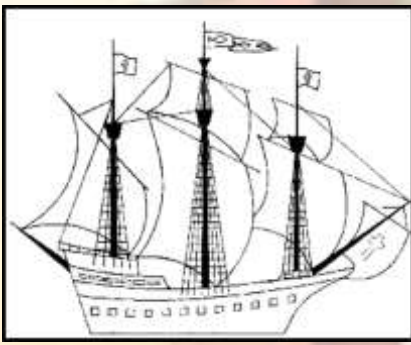

#### Year 4 trip to Chester

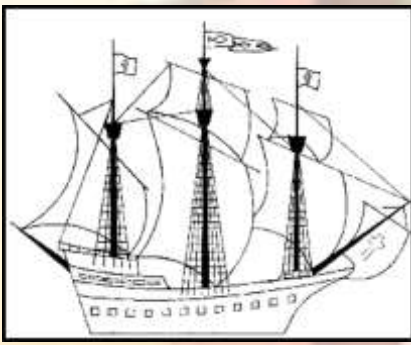
